The Maintenance Supervisor performs a variety of maintenance duties and is responsible for keeping all mechanical systems and equipment properly maintained through both scheduled and as-needed service, as well as assisting in fish culture operations and contributes to "On Call" schedule. Independent judgement and performance is required when initiating and implementing hatchery projects, processes and schedules. The Maintenance Supervisor supervises the work performed by the Maintenance Assistant and Maintenance Technicians.
